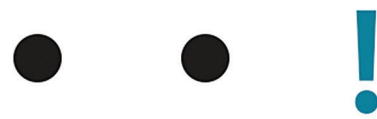


PROTECTING YOUR DEVICE WHILE TRAVELING

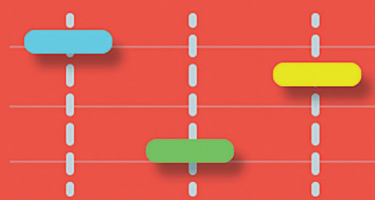
You are ready for your trip, but is your smartphone? What about your laptop or tablet?

1 Maintain strong complex passwords

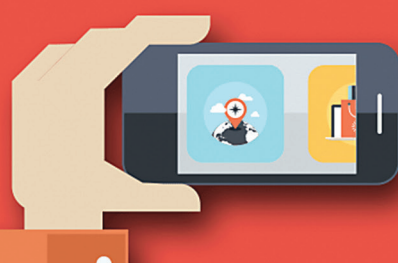


2 Make sure your software is up-to-date.
